

Departure instructions (Summer season)

- 1. Preventing High Winds or Hurricanes: Make sure you do not leave anything outside: Debris, wood, building materials, bikes, barbecue, or anything that could cause damage to your property or nearby properties. Instead, store your belongings in the house or shed.
- 2. Please anchor your golf cart. Close shutters for those who have them.
- 3. You can leave a motion detection light activated but permanent light is not recommended: It will attract termites during the swarming season: (May and June).
- 4. Change the thermostat batteries of your air conditioner to prevent a breakdown during the summer.
- 5. Make sure you lock your doors and block the windows. Do a final inspection of your property.
- 6. You can complete the "HOME WATCH REQUEST FORM", which after completion can be brought to the office to be forwarded to the police.
- 7. Make sure the payment of your common expenses are up to date. We advise you to use automatic bank withdrawals to have peace of mind.
- 8. You must take care of the surveillance of your property during the summer: Have someone inspect your home and notify you of any problems that may occur during your absence. (Air conditioner failure, water leaks etc ...)
- 9. You must appoint a person to maintain your property outside: Weeds or other vegetation that needs cutting.
- 10. If you decide to forward your mail to Canada, you may obtain the required form directly at the post office. Fill in the request and put it in the mailbox at the front.
